

The 'Officer Certification Program' is Not Just Another Leadership Training Class. The OCP is Training for Our Leaders.

OCP Training is for all Operations Officers; Directors and Assistant Directors at all levels (Chapter, District, and Region) throughout GWRRA. If you signed a Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU), then there is a need for you to attend. Rider Educators may attend if they so desire. Spouses of officers are not required to attend this training. This training is FREE of charge and is open to all GWRRA participants.

The first OCP Class to be held in Georgia will take place on February 27th & 28th, at the Heritage Bank, located at 440 North Jeff Davis Drive in Fayetteville, GA. This is a 1 ½-day class. All officers and those members attending will need to register. Please use the Training Registration Form found on the Georgia District Website under Leadership Training. On the line indicating the Class Desired, write "OCP, 27-28 Feb" and then complete the rest of the information that is requested and send it (or email the information) to Sharon and me. The class will start promptly at 8:30 AM on both Saturday & Sunday. We should finish around 4-5:00 PM on Saturday, and finish around noon on Sunday. This bank is located just down the street from the I-Hop restaurant where GA-P meets. If you are planning to attend, please register promptly as there are workbooks to be ordered and handouts that need to be copied, as well as names to be entered on the completion certificates.

Dates and locations for additional OCP Training will be identified at a later date. All class dates and locations for all Regions and Districts will be posted on the National GWRRA Website. You may attend any OCP class at any location identified as all materials used are identical, and all District and Region Trainers have been certified to teach this program. Should you plan to attend this training in another District, please contact their District Trainer to obtain their specific registration requirements.
