

I have taught CPR First aid for many years but never dreamed I would have a heart attack. The good news is, I knew what to do when it happened. I could have just blown it off as indigestion, because that is what I thought it was until I took my blood pressure. Then I knew that something was not right and it was time to get to the hospital. While there, we found out that we were having a heart attack. I had 2 blockages that they were able to fix. The good news is that we caught it in time and there was no heart damage.

With all this said, I come to the important part. All the training in the world can't help you if you do not use the knowledge that you were taught. Please, if you haven't taken First Aid CPR please do so. It may very well save your life, as it has mine.

Melinda and I would like to thank everyone that called, came by, and sent cards it was gratefully appreciated.

I look forward to seeing you in class in the days to come.
