GWRRA Motorist Awareness Updates

FYI and most of you probably already know this, each month in your Wing World Magazine there is a 2-page spread titled Field Updates. In this section each of the GWRRA National Program Directors give you some really good stuff on what is going on in GWRRA for each of their programs.

In the November 2017 Wing World, on pages 22 & 23, the Field Update Section had the following MAP article.

Motorist Awareness – by Cliff & Char Simpson, Asst Directors, MAP

Planning a Motorist Awareness (MA) event can be a big deal – or not. In recent comments, GWRRA President, Anita Alkire, said our Chapters need to get back to the basics. We should get together to socialize, ride, and most of all, have fun. How does that fit with the Motorist Awareness Program (MAP)? As an example, your Chapter has planned a 250-mile round trip, with a stop in Truckville for lunch. They also want to incorporate some kind of MA event. But how do they go about it? Think about the five W's: Who, What, When, Where and Why

– The Basics.

First, decide on your objective. WHY are you doing this? Do you want to show people that we are “regular” folks, just like them? Perhaps you want to tell folks about the safety gear that we wear.

After you have determined your objective, decide WHERE you want to carry out this activity. Let's say you are going to talk with the folks visiting the diner at your lunch stop. Gut wait? Do we need permission from the owner to display our bikes and talk with their patrons? Is the parking area large enough to do this and not restrict parking or movement for the other patrons?

WHO will be willing to participate? How many folks normally go on such a ride? Will most feel comfortable talking to the public? Do we need to give them some ideas of how to approach people and how to start a conversation?

WHAT supplies will we need? Are we setting up an awning for a booth? Or are we using our rides as the magnet? Do we need a sign or banner? What about handout materials? Do we want to get some GWRRA MA brochures?

I hope you see from my example that you can have a successful MA event with minimal planning. Can you do it as a spur-of-the-moment activity? Absolutely! A little basic planning using the five W's will help insure your success.

I would encourage you to read these updates every month and talk to your Chapter or District Director if you have any questions about any of this information.


