RIDE SAFE—CHECK YOUR TIRES!

Now it is 2019 and we travel on to see what it will bring. Hopefully, the weather will be better, and we won't have as much sickness as last year so we can get a lot more riding in.

Now is the time for you to get that bike out of storage and get it ready to ride! Check the tires, look on the side of the tire and find the date code. If the tire is over 5 years old you need to change them out.

Look at the valve stem. Move it back and forth and look for cracks where it touches the rim. Spray it with a little soap and water to see if it leaks. Replace it if you are in doubt. Check the air pressure. Please look in your bike's manual and fine the correct pressure for your bike. This is one of the most important things you can do to maintain your tires.

Most motorcycle tires will dry rot before they wear out, so be safe and get some new ones.

When installing new tires don't forget to replace the valve stems.

Ride safe and often.


