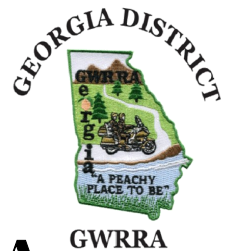

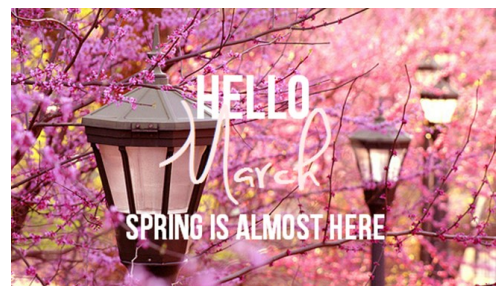
We are offering this contest to Georgia GWRRA and other states as well, so spread the word and the pot will grow. Have fun and you might win!

Did You Know...

An issue was recently brought to my attention regarding the monthly Motorist Awareness Program Activity Report.

This is a form that is filled out by the District MAP Coordinator and submitted to the Director and Assistant Directors of the Motorist Awareness Program and the District Director on a monthly basis. This form identifies Motorist Awareness Activities and provides an area where additional information can be added.

The monthly Motorist Awareness Activity Report is a very simple report in which Motorist Awareness Activities and events are listed next to a check box. No number counts are necessary – Do the event, check the box.

As we know, GWRRA President Anita Alkire has told all GWRRA Chapters that reporting is a thing of the past. *GWRRA Chapters are not required to fill out or submit monthly Motorist Awareness Program Activity Forms.*

District Motorist Awareness Coordinators support their Chapters by writing brief articles in their District Newsletters and by sharing tips on presentations, talking points, and other Motorist Awareness activities. They also encourage Chapter Directors to be on the lookout for those Members who are passionate about Motorist Awareness. These Members may be candidates for the Gold Award, and Chapter Directors may wish to offer them a staff Motorist Awareness position. It should be noted that Chapter Motorist Awareness positions are no longer a requirement. Motorist Awareness can be incorporated into every event, and every Member is a participant!

Because Chapter Directors know their Members, Chapter needs, and Chapter activities better than anyone else, many District Motorist Awareness Program Coordinators have asked Chapters to voluntarily fill out and submit a monthly MAP Activity Report. If you are a Chapter Director who is willing to fill out the monthly MAP Activity Report, or if your Chapter has a Motorist Awareness staff position, that's great! We thank you for your effort! Not only does it provide the Motorist Awareness Program with more detailed information – it also makes it easier to track Chapter Members for the Motorist Awareness Program Gold Award! Filling out and submitting a monthly MAP Activity form to your District MAP Coordinator is a courtesy that is very much appreciated – but once again – it is NOT required.

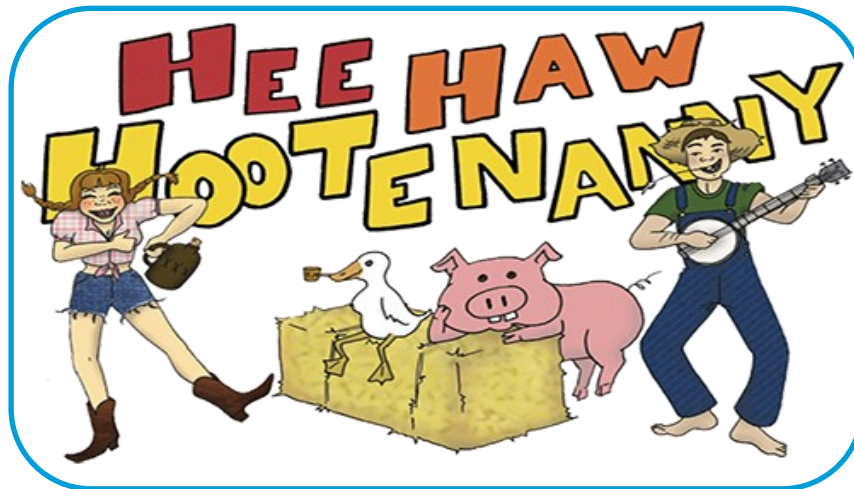
