# Gold Wing Road Riders Association Horizons Program

The GWRRA Horizons Program is a two-day learning experience designed for new, current, and prospective Chapter Officers. It consists of a series of classroom presentations and workshop sessions. The program includes such topics as GWRRA Organization and Philosophies; Officer Expectations and Responsibilities; Individual Personal Profiles; Communication Skills and Techniques; Planning, Organizing, and Conducting Effective Chapter Meetings, Gatherings, and Events; the Officer/Spouse Relationship; and several other important topics.

The class session will start promptly at 8:30 AM on Saturday morning, August 11, 2007, and conclude no later than 2:00 PM on Sunday, August 12, 2007. Participants must be able to attend all sessions (both days) to receive credit for program attendance. There is a \$10 Registration fee which will be collected on Saturday morning, Aug 11.

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## Other Classes and Programs

All one-day classes (Instructor Development & Certification, Knowledge Enhancement, and Intermediate Leadership Skills) will be conducted at Priester's Pecans, I-75 South, Exit 134 at South Perry Parkway and Highway 41, Perry, GA.

Classes will begin at 9:00 AM and will conclude no later than (NLT) 4:00 PM.

Priester's has an excellent all-you-can-eat lunch buffet, including drink and dessert for \$6.99.

The Instructor Development and Certification Program is open to anyone with a desire to become a certified GWRRA Instructor. Once certified, instructors will be asked from time to time to assist with teaching one or more seminars in any of the Leadership Training Programs being offered. Certified instructors will receive a sew-on patch and a hanger bar for their Leadership Training Pin.

The Knowledge Enhancement Program is also open to anyone wishing to attend. This is a follow-on to the Horizons Program. The Horizons Program teaches the "Why" of what goes on in a GWRRA Chapter; the Knowledge Enhancement teaches the "How" to make those things happen. A hanger bar is provided at the completion of this program which consists of eight seminars, all of which can be provided in a one-day session.

Intermediate Leadership Training Skills Program is available to all members who have completed both the Horizons and the Knowledge Enhancement Programs. All CDs and ACDs are strongly encouraged to complete at least eight of the nine seminars in this program. These seminars are focused primarily on the Assistant Chapter Directors, or any member for that matter, that will be stepping up to the position of Chapter Director. A hanger bar will be provided to those members completing this program.
